How do I know What Area I'm In

Many have asked how the areas are defined. If you're not sure then here is a quick general guide.

Area 1: Nassau County from the NYC Line to the line created by the Meadowbrook Pkwy and Glen Cove Rd.

Area 2: Nassau County from the line created by the Meadowbrook Pkwy and Glen Cove Rd. to the Suffolk County line.

Area 3: Basically Babylon and Huntington Townships.

Area 4: Basically Islip and Smithtown Townships.

Area 5: All Points east of Islip and south of Middle Country Rd.

Area 6: All points east of Smithtown and north of Middle Country Rd
